

Mechanical Breaching Courses

The Mechanical Breaching Course Series is Open to both Patrol Officers and Special Operations Officers. However, Patrol / Duty Uniforms and Equipment may not be adequate to accommodate the tool and weapon retention systems and devices within this course. The Level II course will prove challenging without the full equipment compliment.

Students should attend the course wearing the uniform along with the equipment and weapon systems that they would in their specific role. All department standard or mandated equipment to include ballistic protection.

It is recommended to bring Breaching Tools from your department / unit / team. It is preferred to use the same tools in the course that you will use in actual operations. This is not mandatory, we will have tools for you to use during the course.

It is recommended to bring items suited for seasonal or inclement weather.

- Department / Team Rifle Weapon System- Equipped with Single or Two-Point Sling System.
- Gun Belt with Standard Duty or Tactical Loadout.
- Installed Retention Systems
- Eye Protection
- Ear Protection
- Gloves (Knuckle Protection Type Recommended)
